two voices, one cello and one viola.

They **sing and play at the same time, using the instrument to accompany the voice and vice versa.** Their work is characterized by the intimate and raw interaction between two sisters who have been making music together since childhood.

The **multiculturalism in the family is the spine of the sister's artistic work:** half flemish, half Spanish, born in Mexico and Belgium. In the compositions of the second album and the upcoming one, **you can hear chamber-like textures with folk-inspired melodies, African rhythms, and jazz harmonies combined with original texts sung in different languages.**

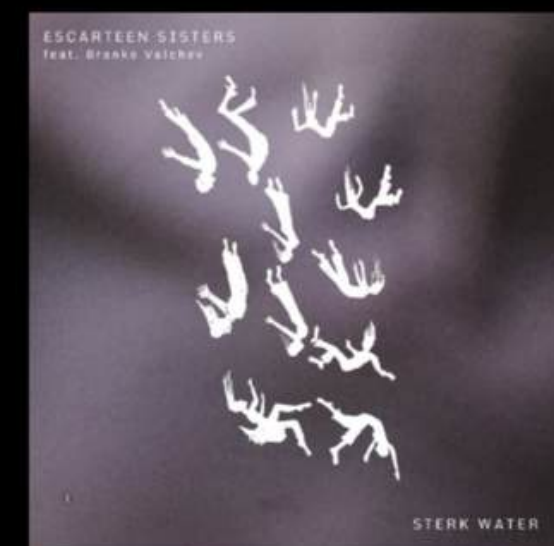

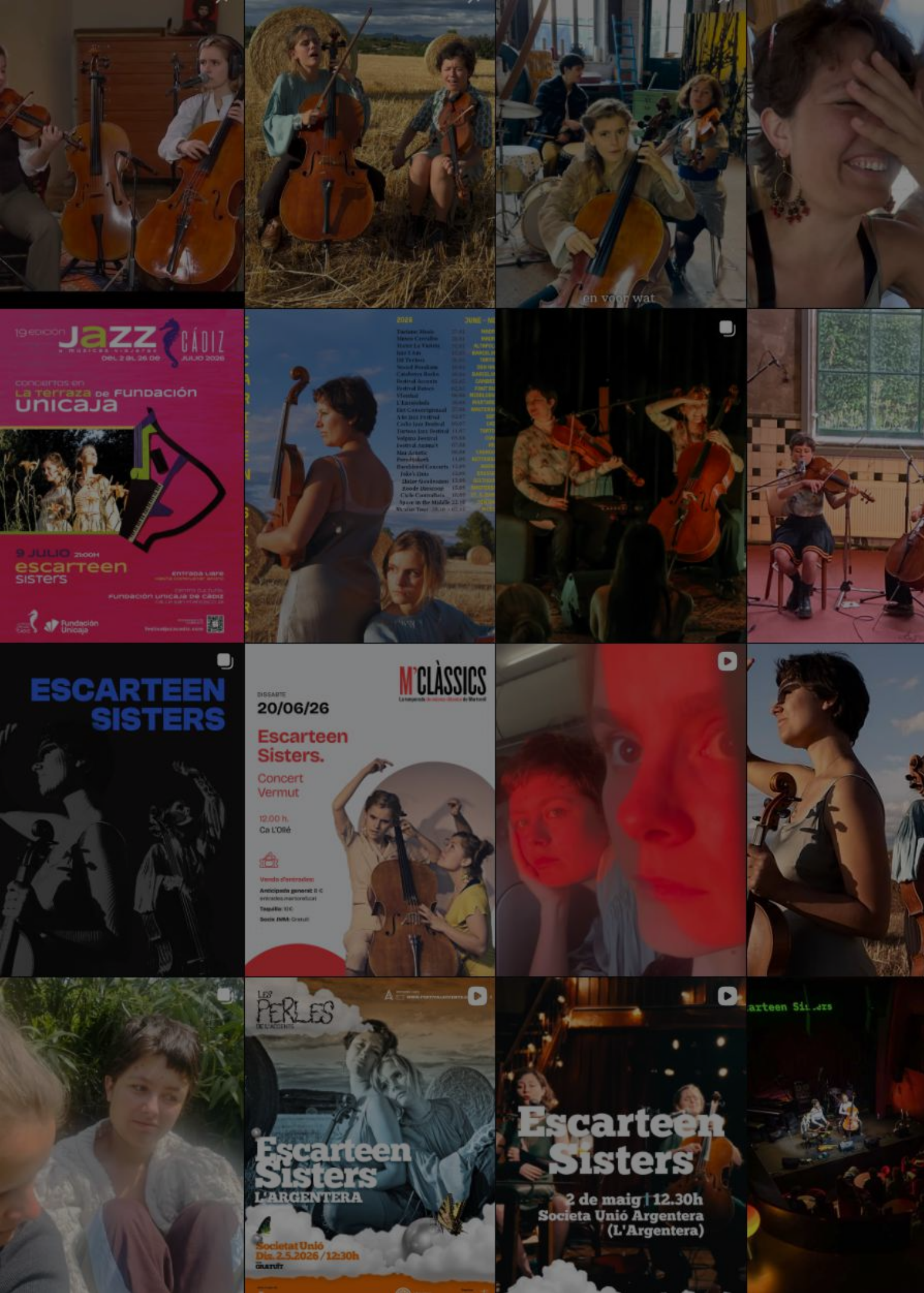
